




SARAH HEDGES GOEDHART

She was born in Buenos Aires and travelled the world with her family in youth before studying business and philosophy at the University of San Diego. It was actually her husband (and fellow winemaker), Brent Goedhart, who inspired her to study winemaking at Washington State University. Sarah joined the family business as assistant winemaker, apprenticed to her uncle, before taking on the role of head winemaker when he retired. In that time, Sarah and her family have converted their estate vineyards to biodynamic farming.

Bringing together her passionate pursuits of wine and science, she founded the Catena Institute of Wine, which works with universities to advance the study of Malbec around the world. As if that wasn't enough to clinch her reputation as a Renaissance woman, she also authored the book Vino Argentino: An Insider's Guide to the Wines and Wine Country of Argentina. Almost certainly the world's only flying winemaker with an active medical practice, she divides her time between Mendoza and San Francisco.

VIRGINIA WILLCOCK

Vasse Felix

Growing up seeing the happiness her parents and family friends felt tending the small vineyard they shared north of Perth, Virginia knew she wanted to make wine her career. She worked vintages in New Zealand, Albania and Italy before returning to Australia and joining the team at Vasse Felix in Margaret River. Virginia feels that the best and most beautiful wines are environmentally expressive - that is, they convey a unique sense of the place where they were grown. Since becoming chief winemaker she has championed a hands-off approach that allows her wines to communicate what the vineyard has to offer.



Waterkloof Wines

Coming from a family of scientists that kept beehives as a hobby, Nadia believes in working in harmony with nature. So it's a natural fit for her as winemaker at biodynamic South African wine estate Waterkloof, which has won awards for its biodiversity and conservation programs. Holder of a B.Sc. in agriculture specializing in viticulture and oenology, her approach is one of pursuing what's proven to work best, not just what's trendy. She and her team still stomp the grapes for their wines by foot and she makes her wines with minimal intervention, wanting wine lovers to taste in the glass what she tastes in the vineyard.

MARIE-PIERRE **MANCIA**T

Marie-Pierre Manciat

Born into a family of vignerons that have been making wine since 1871, Marie-Pierre spent her summers in the family vineyards in France. Her father, Claude, an advocate of quality over quantity in winemaking, instilled in her the value of time-honoured tradition and inspired her to pursue excellence in her wines. Before taking over the family winery, Marie-Pierre had her own pet project, Lacrochette-Manciat, which provided the perfect setting in which to practice her art independently, build confidence, and live firsthand the experiences behind the lessons her father taught. She believes terroir has a tale to tell and lets each site express itself according to its personality.

Marchesi di Barolo in Piedmont, Italy, is not only the cradle of the earliest wines of Barolo, it's also home to one of the wine world's most prominent families. Working alongside her husband, Ernesto, fifth-generation proprietor and vintner Anna Abbona breathed new life into a winery with over two centuries of history when she restored and redesigned the guest reception area of the estate cellars and started a restaurant focused on pairing the wines with traditional Italian cuisine. Anna and Ernesto's daughter, Valentina, represents the sixth generation at Marchesi di Barolo along with her brother Davide. She studied economics and business in Milan before joining the family winery.

TASTING NOTE: As with most Trius wine, this is quite good. It's flavourful, balanced, refreshing and offers a good price point when one considers the quality within. Alluring aromas of red berry fruit and leesy notes mingle with citrus on the nose of this deftly balanced sparkler. It dazzles the palate with strawberry and raspberry fruit flavours robed in piquant spice and excellent tang. The fine-bead bubbles and lengthy flavour-filled, lip-smacking finish speak to high-quality sparkling wine. A perfect welcoming wine to offer company. Traditional method, Okanagan Valley, **British Columbia**

The lot available through this release is based on 2015 fruit and was disgorged in May of 2018.

TASTING NOTE: The standard for a reason, and the latest release of Gold Label Brut doesn't disappoint. In fact, it feels even sprightlier and livelier than ever. The latest release is based on 2015 fruit and disgorged in March 2018 - key intel on the back label. Okanagan Falls estate pinot noir and chardonnay is splashed with five percent pinot gris before two years on the lees. All are whole cluster pressed, and fermented separately before blending. Lemon zest leads this NV, with green apple, light biscuit, chalk across a nimble, lemony palate. Lively, bright and complete, striking a perfect chord between the bright acidity and the 8 g/I RS, this is deserving of its classic status and one of Canada's best bubbles, year after year. THE **TRADITIONAL** METHOD

This is the most labour-intensive and time-consuming process for producing sparklers and results in the most complex, textured wines. All Champagnes, and many fine sparkling wines such as **Crémants**, are made using this process. The method is also known as **méthode classique** and **metodo classico**. These wines are designated as **Cava** in Spain and **Méthode Cap Classique** in South Africa.

During **primary fermentation**, a dry, still base wine is made from hand-harvested grapes. Liqueur de tirage (a mixture of sugar and yeast) is added to the mixture and bottled, triggering a **secondary fermentation**. The bottle is sealed with a crown cap. This second fermentation lasts from 6 to 8 weeks. The wine is aged on the lees (dead yeast cells) in bottle, which imparts the traditional method's signature bread, biscuit and toast notes. The bottles are slowly rotated (called riddling) so that the dead yeast is collected in the neck. Finally, the yeast sediment is removed and the **dosage** (a wine and sugar solution) is added before **corking**.

PONGRÁZ CAP CLASSIQUE ROSÉ

Traditional method, WO Western Cape, South Africa

TASTING NOTE: Crafted from the classic Champagne blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Both were hand-harvested, the Pinot coming from sites planted at 320 metres altitude and the Chardonnay from vines at between 100 and 200 metres. This is rich and solid with beautifully articulated red berry and fruit tones and evocative autolytic notes of bread and yeast. Textured and long, and impressive in all ways. Try with spiced chicken thighs, roasted pork loin or charred shrimp. (Vintages panel, June 2018)

TASTING NOTE: I did not taste this aromatic Cava a few years back and have to believe that great improvements have been made. The Brut Nature ideology is well-suited to Cava and here closer to excellent. Aromas deliver rusticity, wild ginger, wet stone and concrete. Stone fruit (as a departure) indicates ripeness and then what matters, matters most and that is texture. Lovely Cava worth setting one or two aside to see what might happen. Drink 2017-2020. THE TANK METHOD

Also known as the **Charmat** method or as cuve close, this process also begins with the creation of a dry base wine, which is then placed in a stainless-steel tank along with the sugar and yeast required for the **secondary** fermentation. The wine is bottled and sealed under pressure. While this method produces high-quality wines, it's less labourintensive and therefore less expensive than the traditional method. The tank method is used throughout the world, most famously in the production of Prosecco, which can be made as a sparkling or semi-sparkling wine and is beloved for its freshness and fruity character. Where the traditional method imparts rich autolytic notes that can overpower subtle floral and fruit tones, the tank method allows the fruit to shine, making it the best option for sparkling wines made from aromatic grapes such as Riesling.







LET'S CHILL

All sparkling wines should be thoroughly chilled prior to serving. This means 2-3 hours in a fridge or 20-30 minutes in an ice bucket. Bubbly is great for marking important milestones; a glass immediately adds a touch of sophistication to an anniversary dinner, for example. Cottage time will soon be upon us, and sparkling's refreshing character makes it great for relaxing on the deck. Even movie nights don't need to be ordinary; traditional-method wines are awesome with popcorn. And few things are as perfect, after any meal, as a glass of Champagne.





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
