RUTHERFORD RANCH CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2016

Napa Valley, California 073817 (XD) 750 mL \$39.95 ✓

TASTING NOTE: This is an expressive blend of 85% cabernet sauvignon, 7% malbec, 4% merlot, 3% petite sirah and 1% petit verdot. Aromas of blackberry and raspberry punctuated with notes of mocha and vanilla waft from the glass. It's medium-full bodied with good structure, juicy acidity, moderate tannins and juicy palate flavours of cherry, raspberry and vanilla. The finish is lengthy and tangy. Pair with barbequed lamb chops. Score: **90** (Dave Isaacs, *winecurrent.com*, May 6, 2019)

LEALTANZA RESERVA 2012

DOCa Rioja, Spain 208223 (XD) 750 mL \$22.95 ●

TASTING NOTE: 100% Tempranillo. Rounded and layered aromas of dried fruits, red cherry, smoke and coconut. Well polished and presented with red fruit and plum flavours sluicing through the palate. It is, simply, a beautiful wine with the X-factor. Score: **97** (Decanter Asia Wine Awards, 2018)

Albariño / Alvarinho

This is an ancient grape variety of noted quality, perhaps best known for the Vinho Verde wines of Portugal.

Where It's Grown

Widely planted in northwest Portugal (Alvarinho) and on the Atlantic coast of northern Spain (Albariño).

Key Characteristics

- Thick skin and early ripening.
- Produces wines with good weight, high acidity, and quite intense flavours.
- Can create wines that are fruity and floral, with orange citrus, lemongrass, honeysuckle, peach and apple. Some versions accentuate a saline minerality.
- These wines can be light or quite full-bodied and textured depending on how they're aged.
- In Spain, it's often aged in oak and sometimes fermented in oak, though more and more it's being matured in stainless steel.
- Aging on the lees (yeast) can impart a rich, pleasing texture to the wines.

Perfect Pairings

These are ideal wines for seafood, spinach salads, and lightly seasoned chicken.

CASTELO DO MAR ALBARIÑO 2018 DO Rías Baixas, Spain

This comes from a producer that is fairly new to Ontario, but with over 30 years of winemaking prowess backing up this wine, Castelo do Mar is not exactly new to the game. This will be a floral, pretty wine that will offer suggestions of honey, pear, peach and citrus. Always balanced and lively, this will be superb with grilled shrimp or your favourite seafood stew.

DEU LA DEU ALVARINHO 2018

Monção e Melgaço, DOC Vinho Verde, Portugal

Founded in 1958, Adega de Monção is one of Portugal's leading brands and is a fine example of the evolution in quality that people have come to expect from Vinho Verde wines. Look for characterful, on-point notes of fresh green apple, grapefruit, white peach, garden herbs and stony mineral and a steely, vibrant acidity. Pair with grilled herbed fish or seafood appetizers with garlic butter and lemon.

Cortese

Cultivated in Piedmont for hundreds of years, Cortese is responsible for the famed wines of Gavi, which many consider among Italy's finest whites.

Where It's Grown

Grown virtually exclusively in Piedmont where it's used in blends, Cortese reaches its pinnacle expression as a varietal wine, such as those from Cortese dell'Alto, Monferrato and Colli Tortonesi. Its most famous iteration is undoubtedly the wines of Gavi in the south of Piedmont.

Key Characteristics

- Thin skin, vulnerable to rot.
- Outside of the Gavi region, Cortese can have difficulty ripening. In other parts of Piedmont, it can produce incredibly high levels of acidity, making it more desirable as a component for blends or a base for sparkling wines rather than a varietal wine.
- Gavi wines are typically dry, notably fresh and crisp, and gently aromatic, with citrus and mineral notes.

Perfect Pairings

These wines are ideal for seafood; Gavi was originally produced to supply the perfect wine for the fish restaurants of Genoa and the Ligurian coast.

BANFI PRINCIPESSA GAVIA GAVI DOCG, Piedmont, Italy

Legend has it that Principessa Gavia, daughter of the King of the Franks, fell in love with a soldier and the two fled to northwest Italy to escape her disapproving father. The village and wine of Gavi are named after her. This fetching wine features refreshing citrus,

peach and pear. A great sipper or aperitif, it will also be a fine match for salads, seafood antipasti or lighter fish mains.

DOCG, Piedmont, Italy

Marchesi di Barolo has been a major contributor to successful dining for over five generations. The wines for Gavi di Gavi are made from the Cortese grape and must come from the township of Gavi itself. They tend to have more heft and impact than wines from the larger Gavi DOCG. Expect a floral, bright wine with juicy apple, lemon and underlying mineral. Perfect for sipping or for seafood dishes.

Grenache

The powerhouse grape of the South of France, Grenache is a key component in many of your favourite wines. It's the "G" in Australia's extremely popular GSM wines, where it's blended with Shiraz and Mataro (Mourvèdre). In Spain, it's known as Garnacha.

Where It's Grown

Grenache is a principal grape in blends across the South of France from Roussillon to Provence, including the pinnacle of French Grenache: Châteauneuf-du-Pape. In Spain, it's the most widely planted grape after Tempranillo, with which it's often blended.

Key Characteristics

- · Thin skin, late ripening.
- Extremely well-suited to hot, arid conditions.
- · All Châteauneuf-du-Pape reds contain Grenache, and some are made exclusively from it.
- Old-vine Grenache can make intense, concentrated wines with decades of ageing potential.
- Grenache is notably rich and spicy with red berry fruit tones.
- Rosé wines made from Grenache are among the most characterful in the world.

Perfect Pairings

Grenache is a winner with any form of roasted or grilled meat.

SAINTES PIERRES DE NALYS CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE 2016

AC, Rhône, France (E. Guigal)

TASTING NOTE: This is a fleshy and dense offering, with layers of warm cassis, plum sauce and cherry preserve flavors seamlessly entwined, while warm fruitcake and melted red licorice notes fill in through the finish. There's a whiff of smoky tea at the very end, while the fruit plays out. Best from 2020 through 2034. Score: 93 (James Molesworth, winespectator. com, March 31, 2019)

SOBILANE GRENACHE/SYRAH 2015

IGP Côtes Catalanes, Roussillon, France (1752 Signature Wines)

TASTING NOTE: Reminding me of a release from Jean-Marc Lafage with its ripe, yet incredibly pure and charming personality, the 2015 Côtes Catalanes from Sobilane (60/40 Grenache and Syrah) offers outstanding notes of blackberries, jammy raspberries, spice and garrigue. Drink this full-bodied, sexy, hedonistic beauty over the coming 2-3 years. Drink date: 2017-2020. Score: 92 (Jeb Dunnuck, robertparker.com, April 28, 2017)

Nebbiolo

Known as the King of Piedmont and one of the most, if not *the* most, celebrated grapes in Italy, Nebbiolo creates expressive, age-worthy wines of outstanding excellence and quality.

Where It's Grown

Nebbiolo is a finicky, challenging grape that's only grown successfully in Piedmont.

Key Characteristics

- Early budding, late ripening, and quite difficult to grow.
- Its exacting soil requirements (it prefers calcareous marls) have limited its success outside
 of Piedmont. This finicky disposition has seen it compared with Pinot Noir, another
 notoriously challenging grape to grow.
- Like Pinot, Nebbiolo is quite light-coloured, but turns orange in the bottle far quicker than
 most red wines. Young Nebbiolo wines can therefore appear older than other styles of the
 same vintage.
- The wines are characterized by high acidity and exceptionally grippy tannins.
- The best Nebbiolo wines are delightfully perfumed, with haunting, complex aromas that can include dried cherries, violets, roses, tar, cordite and licorice.
- Nebbiolo is the basis for 17 DOC and DOCG wines, but Barolo and Barbaresco are its most famous expressions.

Perfect Pairings

Try it with meaty stews, lamb, game meats, or black truffle risotto.

DAMILANO LISTE BAROLO 2013

DOCG, Piedmont, Italy

TASTING NOTE: You get both power and elegance here, as pressed rose and lavender mingle with grilled herb, licorice and dark smoke. The 2013 Barolo Liste has structure and big bones. It is engineered for long cellar aging of one or two decades. Some 7,400 bottles were made. Drink date: 2020-2035. Score: **94+** (Monica Larner, *robertparker.com*, April 30, 2019)

MICHELE CHIARLO REYNA BARBARESCO 2015

DOCG, Piedmont, Italy

TASTING NOTE: A delightful nose of dried red plums, rose petals, dried herbs, vanilla, cedar, leather and dried spices. Full body, chewy and structured tannins and a long, succulent finish. Drink in 2022. Score: **94** (James Suckling, jamessuckling.com, Sept. 24, 2018)

Glera (Prosecco)

You may know Glera as Prosecco. The name was changed in 2009 to differentiate between the grape and the Prosecco DOCG appellation.

Where It's Grown

Glera has long been associated with Veneto in northern Italy, especially as the super-popular sparkling wine Prosecco.

Key Characteristics

- A late-ripening grape with high acidity that makes it ideal for crafting sparkling wine. It's used to make some still wines, but most have some fizzy element to them.
- Floral and fruity with green apple, peach, pear and melon tones.

Perfect Pairings

Prosecco is a fun, refreshing sipper that also goes well with everything from nuts to charcuterie platters.

TORRESELLA PROSECCO

DOC, Venezie, Italy

TASTING NOTE: This provides great value as a light-onits-feet sipper pouring well as a welcoming wine or when paired with lighter-styled appetizers. Toast, honey and earthy notes on the nose, it glides smoothly across the palate with mouth-watering flavours of lemon yoghurt, green tea and honey-tinged pear. This extra-dry Prosecco finishes in a blaze of mouth-watering tang...clean, crisp and refreshing. Score: **89** (Vic Harradine, winecurrent.com, April 23, 2018)

Grüner Veltliner

The signature grape of Austria, the versatile Grüner was the hit of restaurants in the '90s and early 2000s and remains a sommelier go-to for customers looking for something beyond Chardonnay.

Where It's Grown

Grown in Austria – principally in Lower Austria where it accounts for more than half of the total grape production.

Key Characteristics

- Ripens too late for most regions in northern Europe.
- Offers grapefruit and lemon citrus with some stone fruit and a signature white pepper note.
- Produced in two main styles: a light, fresh, mineral wine that can include some spritz; and a more intense, full-bodied, complex, spicy style reflective of some warmer growing regions.
- The second style sometimes sees some time in oak.
 The more intense-styled wines can require some ageing before they're ready to drink.

Perfect Pairings

The fresh, light style makes an excellent sipper and is ideal for fish and salads. The fuller wines can be served with chicken or grilled pork dishes.

RABL LÖSS GRÜNER VELTLINER 2017

Langenlois, DAC Kamptal, Austria

TASTING NOTE: Kamptal is one of the best regions for Austria's signature white. This one is floral and fresh-tasting, with honey and citrus overtones and a refined underlying minerality. Ideal for seafood. (Vintages panel, Sept. 2018)

Sangiovese

Sangiovese is the grape behind Chianti, Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano. It's often blended with Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot to create some of Tuscany's best-known IGT wines.

Where It's Grown

Though most famously associated with the red wines of Tuscany, Sangiovese is Italy's most widely planted grape, found in over half of Italy's wine regions.

Key Characteristics

- Thin-skinned and vulnerable to rot. A slow- and late-ripening variety that is, however, quite resistant to drought.
- The wines it makes have a pronounced balance and a great food-friendly freshness provided by the high acidity. They can also have quite firm tannins.
- Typical flavours include dark berry, cherry, plum, raspberry, dried herbs and tomato leaf.

Perfect Pairings

Excellent with grilled peppers, tomato-based sauces, and grilled vegetables and meats.

ROCCA DELLE MACÌE FAMIGLIA ZINGARELLI RISERVA CHIANTI CLASSICO 2016

DOCG, Tuscany, Italy

TASTING NOTE: Sweet ripe plum and black cherry fruit counter the leather, earth and macchia flavors in this expressive red. Well-built, with dusty tannins and a savory aftertaste. Best from 2021 through 2035. Score: **93** (Bruce Sanderson, winespectator.com, Aug. 31, 2019)

DOCG, Tuscany, Italy

TASTING NOTE: The 2013 Brunello di Montalcino exhibits a nicely balanced presentation with dark fruit layers that are embellished by well-managed oak spice and savory smoke. This vintage is particularly elegant and tight, with streamlined intensity that builds slowly in the glass as the wine takes on more volume and general breathing space. The finish is long, silky and should well endure the test of time. Drink date: 2020-2035. Score: 93 (Monica Larner, robertparker.com, Feb. 28, 2018)














Tempranillo

Spain's most famous grape, Tempranillo forms the foundation of nearly all of the finest red wines from Rioja.

Where It's Grown

Most well-known in Rioja, Tempranillo is also a key grape in many of Portugal's greatest wines, including Port. In Portugal it's known as Aragonez and Tinta Roriz.

Key Characteristics

- Early ripening, with small thick-skinned berries.
- Capable of producing wines of great elegance and power.
- Can create wines that suggest strawberries, blackcurrants and cherries, as well as leather, earth, prunes, chocolate and tobacco.
- In Rioja, ageing in American oak adds notes of vanilla and coconut.

Perfect Pairings

Among the most versatile of food wines, Tempranillo will pair with lamb, sausages, tacos, pizza, smoky ribs and tomato-based sauces.





Alexana Winery


Born and raised in a small village outside of Bangalore, India, a young Madaiah Revana spent his childhood helping his family grow rice, vegetables and coconuts on their farm. Fast-forward to the 1990s, and **Dr. Madaiah** Revana, MD, had become a cardiologist living and working in the United States as well as a fervent collector of the wines of Bordeaux and Burgundy. Determined to produce world-class wines in the US, he founded Revana Family Vineyard in the Napa Valley in the late 1990s and dedicated it to producing wines from Bordeaux grapes. His quest to add great Pinot Noir to his repertoire led him to Oregon, where, in 2005, he founded Alexana Winery, which he named for his daughter.

Cloudline Cellars


The Drouhin family, having made wine in Burgundy for over a century, recognized the potential for great Pinot Noir in Oregon and purchased their first vineyard there in 1987. Born into this esteemed lineage, fourthgeneration vigneron **Véronique Drouhin-Boss** was making wines for several of her family's outposts in Beaune and Oregon by the time she signed on as consulting winemaker for Cloudline Cellars when it was founded in 2002. One of the great modern "flying winemakers," she continues to make fine wines on both sides of the pond.

CLOUDLINE PINOT NOIR 2017

Willamette Valley (Drouhin Family)

TASTING NOTE: This leaps from the glass with lifted aromas of spice box and red berry fruit aromas. Crunchy red fruit – currant, pie cherry and cranberry – dominate palate flavour, decorated with peppery spice, grilled savory herbs and polished tannin adding interest. It's medium weight with satin-smooth texture and a lengthy, dry, mouthwatering finish and aftertaste. Pour with smoked duck breasts or coq au vin. A Vic Pick. Score: **92** (Vic Harradine, winecurrent.com, Oct. 21, 2018)

Foris Winery & Vineyards

While studying political science and public administration at Cal State Hayward in the late 1960s, **Ted Gerber** developed a passion for making homemade wine. In 1971, he and his wife, Meri, purchased hillside property in southern Oregon's remote Illinois Valley with the intention of growing grapes. The vines they planted and farmed produced the first wine grapes in southern Oregon and, after a dozen harvests selling fruit to other wineries, they began making their own wines in 1986 under the Foris label. To this day, Foris remains the southernmost winery in Oregon.

FORIS ROGUE VALLEY PINOT NOIR 2017

Estate grown, Rogue Valley

TASTING NOTE: This wine was grown on the Cedar Ranch and Maple Ranch estate vineyards in the Rogue Valley appellation of southern Oregon. It's silky and balanced with suggestions of cranberry, raspberry, cherry and oak spice, and a lengthy finish. A lovely wine, and a good choice for roast turkey or prime rib. Best through 2022. (Vintages panel, March 2019)

Penner-Ash Wine Cellars

After studying botany, viticulture and oenology at UC Davis, **Lynn Penner-Ash** made wines at Stag's Leap Wine Cellars, Domaine Chandon and Chateau St. Jean before she and her husband, Ron, moved to Oregon in 1988. There, she became Oregon's first high-profile female winemaker while working at Rex Hill Vineyards until, in 1998, she and Ron founded Penner-Ash Wine Cellars. They completed a sustainable, gravity-flow estate winery in 2005, and today their wine portfolio spans seven appellations in Willamette Valley.

PENNER-ASH PINOT NOIR 2016


Willamette Valley

TASTING NOTE: "In 2016 we had access to vineyard sites that came with the purchase by Jackson Family Wines," Lynn Penner-Ash explains. "Those sites brought some freshness to the wines. They are fresher and livelier than what we saw from the other warm vintages." She also notes that the oak usage dropped quite a bit in 2016, down to about 19%-23% from 20%-40%. Pale to medium ruby-purple in color, the 2016 Pinot Noir Willamette Valley opens with just the slightest touch of gunflint-like reduction on the nose, giving way to red cherries, cranberries and warm raspberry with underlying suggestions of pink peppercorn and flowers. Light to medium-bodied, it gives up great layers of warm red and blue fruits with earthy accents of forest floor, wet earth and bark. It's structured by fine-grained tannins and great juicy acidity carrying the long fruit-forward finish. This is youthfully coiled but should blossom beautifully. Drink date: 2019-2025. Pike Road Wines

The Campbell family had a long history of farming in Oregon when, in 1974, Joe and Pat Campbell planted their first vines on an abandoned and overgrown homestead and started Elk Cove Vineyards at a time when there were just a handful of winegrowers in Oregon. Their son, Adam Campbell, grew up in the vineyard and joined the winemaking team in 1995, becoming head winemaker in 1999. In 2016, he launched a sister winery, Pike Road, with the mission of creating affordable wines from quality Willamette Valley fruit grown on estate and neighbouring vineyards.



Underwood

By the time **Ryan Harms** moved from New York to Oregon in 2001, he had a degree in environmental science under his belt and had worked a harvest in the Willamette Valley, the latter at the suggestion of local winemaker Lynn Penner-Ash. After stints with a few Oregon wineries, he founded Union Wine Company in 2005 with the goal of making unfussy, "pinkies down" Oregonian wines. After a pilot project for canned still wine met with huge success at a Portland event in 2013, Ryan launched the Underwood portfolio with a focus on approachable canned wines.

YES, WE CAN!

You may have noticed a few of your favourite wines have started appearing in cans. This small movement is gaining traction, especially among New World producers. Here's why we like them:

- A can like Underwood's holds 8 oz. perfectly sized for a glass each at a weeknight dinner for two.
- If you're entertaining outside, you can skip the wineglasses, which means bare feet are safer in the backyard or on the cottage deck.
- Cans are airtight, don't let in light and are easy to transport to the cottage (or the campground for a special dinner; alcohol is permitted in most Ontario provincial parks with the exception of certain weekends).

Wine by Joe

Growing up on the family farm in Molalla, just south of Portland, **Joe Dobbes** was given a few acres to farm and devoted them to growing berries which he sold to jam-and-jelly company Smucker's. He turned his hand to winemaking, apprenticed with Dominique Lafon in Burgundy, and, in 1999, made Oregon's first commercial Viognier for Willamette Valley Vineyards. In 2002 he founded Dobbes Family Estates and its counterpart, Wine by Joe, the latter with a focus on approachable wine at affordable prices.

TASTING NOTE: Joe Dobbes' even-handed winemaking consistently delivers reliably tasty and affordable Wine by Joe white wines. 
Looking for a perfect pairing for Thanksgiving dinner? Pick up a Pinot or two.

One of the trickiest varieties to grow and vinify, Pinot Noir is the "holy grail" for many wine producers and wine lovers alike. Happily, our vineyards here in Ontario yield some truly stunning examples. Here, local vintners share what makes Pinot a personal passion.

Pinot Noir is my favourite red grape!" declares **Shauna White**, vineyard manager and winemaker at **Adamo Estate Winery**, who worked in Burgundy, Oregon, BC and Australia before putting down roots in Niagara. "It's well suited for Ontario, especially from specific sites in Niagara, including the Parke Vineyard on the Twenty Mile Bench. Pinot Noir is a challenging grape to grow anywhere in the world and Niagara is no exception, however when managed carefully with premium viticulture this grape expresses the parcel of land it comes from like no other."

"Having spent 35 years of my career working with Pinot Noir from McLaren Vale to the Yarra Valley to the Penedès and to Ontario," muses **Angels Gate** winemaker **Philip Dowell**, "I can say it is the most expressive grape in respect to its growing conditions and winemaking. Ontario offers

the conditions to produce Pinot Noir with all of the hallmark characters of being fragrant, savoury, supple, complex and elegant." AJ McLaughlin, vice-president of sales at Angels Gate, agrees that location is essential but feels the winemaker also deserves credit. "Pinot Noir can be a real diva. It requires a lot of attention and care throughout the growing season, and sometimes even more once it has been pressed and fermented. The entire process is tricky. A winemaker must judge each vintage on its own merits and make several adjustments at each stage to ensure that a complex and balanced wine ends up in the bottle."

"Finely crafted Pinot Noir offers up a bounty of flavours and aromas all wrapped in a silky texture that few other red varieties can match," says **Flat Rock Cellars** winemaker **David Sheppard**. "It's expressive and delicate where other, more tannic red varieties can often be brash. Pinot Noir most certainly is tricky to grow, but given the extra inputs, efforts and expense in doing it right, no other variety gives back the way that it can."

Daniel Speck, co-founder and vice-president at Henry of Pelham, agrees. "Pinot Noir is a finicky grape. It ripens early, and too much heat can cause its thin skins to break down before it fully ripens. So we are always looking for that 'Goldilocks moment' to pick. However, cool-climate Pinot Noir has the most complexity and the widest range of flavours that you will find in virtually any wine. It's in cool climates such as ours that Pinot Noir delivers its greatest expression. These are delicate, complex and delicious wines."
