

LA CREMA SONOMA COAST CHARDONNAY 2017

Sonoma Coast, Sonoma County

TASTING NOTE: ... mostly barrel fermented and aged about eight months in 18% new oak. It surprises with its freshness and restraint. The nose is scented of toast, candle smoke, white peach and poached pears with accents of hay and honeysuckle. It's medium-bodied with a slightly creamy texture and great flavor intensity, refreshed by juicy acidity and finishing long and toasty. This is an incredible value - well made, balanced and tasty. Chardonnay and Pinot Noir arrived in California sometime in the mid-to-late 1800s. Planted in vineyards close to the Pacific Ocean where breezes and fogs create cool-climate growing conditions, these grapes can deliver wines of great vibrancy, precision and restraint. Chardonnays grown in warmer sites deliver full-bodied expressions with exotic tropical flavours, and are crafted to express creamy oak tones.

Zinfandel, known as California's heritage grape, was introduced here between 1852 and 1857. There are numerous old-vine plantings throughout the state, many over 100 years old. California's Zins are concentrated and intense, with brambly red berry flavours and black pepper spice. They can often have a sweet tone from the ripeness of the fruit as well as the residual sugars.

The jewel in California's crown is undoubtedly **Cabernet Sauvignon**. Rich, powerful, ageable and complex, the very best of California's Cabernets possess a level of ripeness and purity of cassis flavour that simply cannot be matched anywhere else in the world.





Sonoma is sunny, warm and dry, and comprises a complex tapestry of rolling hills, benchlands and valleys that extends from the Pacific Ocean to the Mayacamas Mountains. It has 31 different soil types - more than all of France - and the diversity of wines produced here reflects that. Sonoma and its subregions gift us exquisite Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Zinfandel.







The Napa Valley stands shoulder to shoulder with the giants of the wine world. Its reputation, in large part, was made following the stunning 1976 Judgment of Paris tasting when the 1973 Stag's Leap Napa Cabernet took top honours, outshining classified growths from Bordeaux. Ripening grapes is no issue in the warm, sunny Napa Valley, but the region owes much to the ocean-born fogs that moderate the temperatures here; these are a key factor in creating the balance that defines truly high-quality wines.

The **Burgundy** Beat

News flash! Though it's a favourite destination for connoisseurs, **bargains** abound in this venerated French region.

The ancestral home of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, Burgundy is not only one of the oldest and most important of wine regions but also one of the finest. Burgundy's food-friendly, handcrafted wines have set the benchmark for true provenance, but that doesn't mean they're for collectors and connoisseurs alone. This collection will let you experience this iconic region without breaking the bank.





Burgundy Basics

Long and thin, Burgundy is situated in the east-central part of France. The region stretches about 300 kilometres, as the crow flies, from its northernmost growing area, **Chablis** (about 160 kilometres from Paris), to its southernmost growing area, **Mâconnais**. Chablis is cooler than the rest of Burgundy, and Chardonnay here is planted in Kimmeridgian limestone soils that have a high percentage of fossilized sea life, which imparts a distinct saline minerality to the wines. Fresh and bright with a bracingly crisp acidity, Chablis is rarely raised in oak and is strikingly different from Chardonnays grown in the rest of Burgundy, many of which are creamy and rich with significant oak influence.

The vast majority of Burgundy's wines come from a 120-kilometre section roughly in the region's middle that's known as the **Côte d'Or**. The vines here are planted on slopes and face east or southeast, and virtually every tract of land in the region has been graded and ranked in terms of quality wine production. The Côte d'Or is divided into four main growing areas: **Côte de Nuits**, **Côte de Beaune**, **Côte Chalonnaise** and **Mâconnais**. These areas all have individual villages and vineyards of renown. The nuanced variations between parcels of land results in a broad range of expression and variation in the wines, and it's these precise articulations of terroir that have seen Burgundy's Pinot Noirs and Chardonnays become so prized. While Chardonnay and Pinot Noir are the principal grapes of Burgundy, nuanced, characterful Gamay and Aligoté are also made.



Bill Redelmeier is not merely the proprietor of Southbrook, he's the driving force behind the passion that guides every aspect of winemaking there. Knowledgeable, engaging and willing to speak his mind on any topic, Bill embraced organic farming techniques at **Southbrook** not only because

they make environmental sense but also because he felt that he couldn't, in good conscience, "ask his employees to handle and work with harmful chemicals simply for convenience." He believed there had to be a better way, so he found it. In 2005, Southbrook converted a 75-acre vineyard in Four Mile Creek to biodynamic viticulture, the first to be certified in Canada. They added a Jack Diamond-designed, LEED®-Gold-certified pavilion in 2008.

The notion that great wines come from healthy vines seems such a basic idea, but for practitioners of organic and biodynamic farming, like Tawse, the work involved is far from simple. Vines are hand-tended at every stage; a labour-intensive approach that includes hand-harvesting and hand-selecting of the very best fruit. To help control insects, Tawse keeps chickens. Sheep assist in trimming the vine leaves, and wherever possible, horses are used instead of tractors. The care taken extends even to the architecture of the winery, where gravity moves the wine from pressing to cellaring. The wines are aged in underground cellars, and the winery's geothermal energy system has reduced the usage of other energy sources by 80%.

Cave Spring has always been focused on creating wines that reflect the highest standards of quality. Authenticity from vineyard to glass is essential, especially when dealing with the likes of Riesling, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, varietals noted for their ability to express provenance. Cave Spring's sustainable approach to winemaking ensures only a minimal amount of human interference in the development of their wines, resulting in the purest possible expressions. Organic farming techniques, such as the planting of mixed grasses between vine rows to impede weed growth, prevent erosion and improve the soil's nutrient and water levels, further ensure the faithful articulation of their terroir.

Harald Thiel of **Hidden** Bench sees a need for a broad-based environmental approach that is allencompassing. Being certified organic, farming using sustainable practices and employing many biodynamic techniques ensure that not only are Hidden Bench's wines of the highest quality, customers can be confident that they're enjoying wines they can trust. Hidden Bench supports the 1% for the Planet environmental initiative, and the facility and winemaking processes are heated and cooled using geothermal technology. They also generate their own electricity through the use of 135 solar panels.



Riesling is one of the most important grapes in Niagara, where it's made in every style from bone-dry to Icewine to sparkling wine. This off-dry take on the style brings sharply delineated apple and pear, with snappy lemon citrus and a characterful mineral note. This is an utterly charming wine, perfect for casual evenings in with spicy Thai takeout.

STANDOUT SELECTIONS

Lundy Manor is a relative newcomer on the Ontario wine scene, and as eye-catching as the building and grounds may be, it's the wines that are turning heads. Cabernet Franc has performed particularly well in Niagara over recent vintages, and this one is stellar. Sourced from the Foxcroft and Edgerock vineyards, this saw 18 months in oak, but it's the lifted red fruit that really steals the show here.
